Keys to the cottage:

Collection: One of us will meet you on arrival with the keys and show you around the cottage

Departure: Please hand the keys back to Jane or Debbie

Please remember to lock the doors whenever you leave the property.

Rubbish & recycling:

Household waste:

Where to put it: Please place in the bin provided by the barn

Collection day: Tuesday

Recycling:

Where to put it: Please put it in the bin provided marked recycling

Collection day and point: Tuesday

What can be recycled: Clean paper and cardboard, clean plastic containers, clean tins.

Glass bottles and jars should be placed in a separate bag and left next to the recycle bin.

HEATING: Oil fired central heating. All radiators have thermostatic valves so can be individually controlled to achieve the perfect temperature for you

First Aid Kit:

Location: Tall kitchen cabinet

Notes: If you use something from the First Aid box please let us know so we can replace it.

Room by room:

Kitchen: Electric oven, under counter fridge, pasta machine, steamer, range of pots and pans and of course a range of bowls, serving dishes etc. Please use chopping boards to avoid damaging the work surface, please do not place hot pots and pans on the work surfaces.

We hope you will find everything you need in the kitchen. However, if you require any additional items please don't hesitate to ask. We have an additional range of large pots, pans, serving dishes etc. should you require them.

If you are really into your cooking we can provide additional appliances e.g. food mixer, slow cooker, blender, pestle and mortar, baking trays, cake tins etc.

We also have a large range of herbs and spices; please ask us if we have what you need for that special recipe rather than buying it!

Living room: The television and DVD player are linked and operated via the remote control. Please switch off at the mains when not in use.

Bedroom(s): Double bedroom has an en-suite toilet, wardrobe, two bedside tables with drawers and dressing table

Twin bedded room is next to the wet room and has a wardrobe, two bedside tables with drawers and dressing table.

Bathroom(s): The property has one wet room and is fully accessible, there are two toilets in the property

Laundry room: The laundry room is separate from the cottage and is available for your use. It has a washing machine and tumble drier. The iron, ironing board, mop and bucket are also stored in the laundry room, should you require them.

Outdoors:

Barn: A separate freezer is available for use in the barn adjacent to the cottage.

Garden: This is dog proof and is for your sole use. It has a table and chairs for al fresco dining and a 'proper' charcoal barbecue.

Parking: There is spacious parking area right next to the property, screened by a flower bed and is for your sole use.

Farm: You are welcome to stroll around the farm during your stay to see and meet the animals. Please do not feed any of the animals unless you have decided to come and feed them with us at the set times (morning feeding starts at 10.00a.m. during the week and 9.00a.m. at weekends, Afternoon feeding starts at 3.00p.m. weekdays and 4.00p.m. at the weekend). *These times may vary depending on the time of year*

The farm animals are all very friendly, but please do not touch them unless either Debbie or Jane is with you. The exception to this is the goats.....but please remember they are very playful and can be quite boisterous!

Please remember to wash your hands after touching any animals!

Additional Service:

Respite care: Jane is a fully qualified and experienced carer and for an additional charge you can have some 'me' time safe in the knowledge that your loved one will be well cared for. This service is available from 9.00a.m. to 9.00p.m. with a minimum time period of two hours. This service is only available if booked in advance. If you require respite care at short notice during your holiday we will endeavour to meet your needs.

For your information and peace of mind, Jane and Debbie have had enhanced CRB checks due to the nature of the work they do on the Care Farm and are experienced in Safeguarding Children and Vulnerable Adults.
